Vote for Constitution Changes

- Article III added the Academy Program.
- Article VI Restructured the Executive Board to reduce the number of elected officers from 15 to 7. Current At-Large Members will become appointed members, rather than elected members of the Governing Board.
- Article VII Restructured Appointed Members coincident with the Executive Board structure.
- Article VII Reorganized section to group Pro-staff together and volunteers together. Added clarity to top level job descriptions for each.
- Article VIII Increased board meeting attendance requirements to a minimum of 5 meetings per year for Executive board members.
- Article VIII Changed dismissal requirement of an officer from ¾ of board members present to ¾ of Executive Board members.
- Article VIII Added process for removal of a President.

From the SMS Constitution, when an elected member cannot serve their full term: "An elected member may be replaced, via a special election, held at the first Board meeting following the resignation of the officer, by a simple majority of the Board members present. The newly elected member will serve the remaining term of the departing member."



Season Highlights - Referees

- 56 new referees earned their referee badges and joined the ranks in the Spring of 2019
- Two new referee courses were offered in the Winter of 2018-2019 and were filled ~ 35 students per class
- 182 referees are qualified to officiate; of those approximately 25% will respond and officiate each weekend
- In the Spring of 2019, they officiated 332 games. (In the Fall of 2018, they officiated 285 regular season games and 375 small sided tournament games)
- Attrition rate is approximately 40% each year...most referees leave for other opportunities including internships, jobs, and college. (Nationally the attrition rate is 70%)
- Several referees officiate both outdoor soccer (US Soccer Federation) and indoor soccer (US Futsal Federation)

Fields

- Commissioners approved FY20 Budget on Tuesday, May 21 which includes 3 Turf Fields
 - Chaptico Field 1, Chancellors Field 4, & Lancaster field 8
- Adding Lights and irrigation
 - Chancellors 2, Dorsey, 5th District, & Lancaster
- FY2021 CIP has 3 additional Turf fields. This has not yet been approved
- Turf will allow for rest and recovery of existing grass fields
- Continuing to work with county for more irrigation at Chaptico
- Developing a plan for improving fields at Hollywood Soccer Complex

 - Increase involvement of SMS families at the AGM and monthly board meetings
- Better define roles and responsibilities of volunteer and paid staff
- Ensure that policies and processes are in place and easy to find
- Simplify and standardize routine seasonal tasks

Goals for the Coming Year

- Oversee rollout of new Demosphere website
 - Better, more organized layout
 - Improved Coaches Corner with session plans and guidelines for development
- Add a Girls division for the U10 age group
 - 6 all girls teams/8 coed teams based on current projections (2010/2011)
- Offer first SMS sponsored coaches training from United Soccer Coaches
 - August 3rd and 4th
 - 7v7 and 9v9 diploma course
 - Cost covered by club; must be registered to coach during fall 2019
 - Better, smarter coaches = better, smarter players
- Continue to work with county on field improvements
- Seek potential partnership with Capelli Sports
